### **Review of CERIAC guidance A paper by Terry Aston, Secretary CERIAC**

#### **Issues**

1. Deciding whether the leaflet, "Workplace Inspection" (IACL55) is still "fit for purpose."

#### **Backgrounds**

2. Warehouse stocks of the free HSC leaflet "Workplace Inspection - a ceramics industry booklet" produced by the Ceramics Industry Advisory Committee have started to run low.
3. The purpose of this paper is to establish whether the guidance is still relevant and whether it should be reprinted.

#### **The way forward**

4. Members need to decide if -
  - a. the publication is still relevant or if it can be removed from print.
  - b. if it still relevant should it be converted to an information sheet and updated or just reprinted in it's original format.
  - c. if the publication is updated whether the guidance should be modified to include bricks and refractories.

#### **Action**
