#### **Outputs from the Risk Communication Sub Group (RCSG)**

##### ***Implications of the Response to Phillips***

4. At the last RCSG in September, members were interested in the overall implications of the Government's response to the Phillips inquiry for their departments, in terms of risk communication. It was agreed that the Secretariat to the RCSG would produce a short paper for members, setting out the commitments and obligations relating to risk communication in the Government's response to Phillips. This will act as an aid to the planning of work in the various departments.

***Risk communication training and research register***

5. Currently, there is no central information point that sets out what Departments are doing on risk communication training and risk communication research. The RCSG agreed that members would benefit from such a register, which incorporated risk communication training and research initiatives being undertaken by departments. Members will be sending in details of their departmental programmes, which will help to compile the register.
