As you know, there have been a lot of stupid comments in the UK press about the Working at Heights Directive. It was good to see such a strong response from the Commission - the letter was printed in at least two newspapers, one from Antonia Mochan, Brussels and one from Jim Dougal, head of the London EC office.

The only thing we are not sure about is that when the EC letter says "It's clear from the text of the 'working at heights directive' that it applies to working in an industrial or construction context", what is meant by 'industrial' because this implies to us only manufacturing or engineering, and the Directive makes no reference to these specific industries. Can you give us any advice on this?
