

## Approved Supply List

**Note: The Approved Supply List (ASL) consists of over 350 pages of data on specific chemicals which directly reproduces information in Annex 1 of the Dangerous Substances Directive (67/548/EEC). As no changes are proposed to this information as a result of consultation we have not reproduced it here.**

**However, we have attached the appropriate text for the Notice of Approval, together with the Introduction to the proposed 8<sup>th</sup> Edition of the ASL and an extract showing the type and style of information the ASL contains.**

## **NOTICE OF APPROVAL**

The Health and Safety Commission has on [26 July 2005] approved the publication of this document, Approved Supply List for the purposes of the Chemicals (Hazard Information and Packaging for Supply) (Amendment) Regulations 2005 ('CHIP 3.1').

This Approved Supply List shall have effect from [31 October 2005] which is the date on which CHIP 3.1 comes into force.

On that date, the Approved Supply List (7<sup>th</sup> edition) (approved by the Health and Safety Commission on 16 April 2002 for the purposes of the Chemicals (Hazard Information and Packaging for Supply) Regulations 2002) shall cease to have effect.
