



Report on 2017-18 SHAD Programme

Provided to Agriculture Industry Advisory Committee – June 2018

Lantra has now completed the delivery of the 2017-18 Safety and Health Awareness Days (SHAD) programme. This year's programme comprised 12 events as detailed below attended by 3,209 farm staff in total, 831 more than the previous year.

Events followed the same scenario-based format as previous years in all cases the following scenarios were delivered, being deemed the most relevant by HSE.

*Cattle Handling
Working at Heights*

*Machinery Maintenance
Health (Livestock)*

Over 3,000 more invitations were issued than in 2016-17 and together with improved communications, especially the initial invitation letter, total attendance increased by 35%.
