Analysis of the Workers Safety Advisory (WSA) Pilot Scheme

Issue

1 To update members on findings from the analysis of the WSA pilot by York Consulting Ltd.

Background

2 From previous papers and discussions, members are aware of the WSA pilot scheme being carried forward in a number of industries, including construction.

3 The Workers Safety Adviser Pilot ran for 6 months finishing in November 2002. SASD presented a report on the WSA Pilot to the HSC in May 2003. With HSC agreement, a report on the WSA Pilot will be presented to Ministers accompanied by advice concerning possible options for the way forward.

4 York Consulting Ltd was contracted by the HSE to carry out an analysis on the WSA pilot.

5 Matthew Holder will give a PowerPoint presentation to members on the overall findings of the analysis with particular emphasis on the advisors active in the construction industry.
