We continue to monitor documents coming out of this Forum making Members aware through CPI News and the website and getting feedback where applicable.

IOSH “Recover Paper Safely” Courses 2007

Three Company Member courses held to date with 25 delegates taking part however no new courses run since the last PABIAC meeting.

Recovered Paper Sector H & S Advisory Committee 2007

3 meetings held. Committee reviewing stats, delivery, targets and action plan for 2008.

Q1 2007: Compliance with “Recover Paper Safely” report issued to Members. This is being used to determine priority areas for the Committee in 2007 to 2008. Developing an updated recovered paper storage document with support from the HSE.

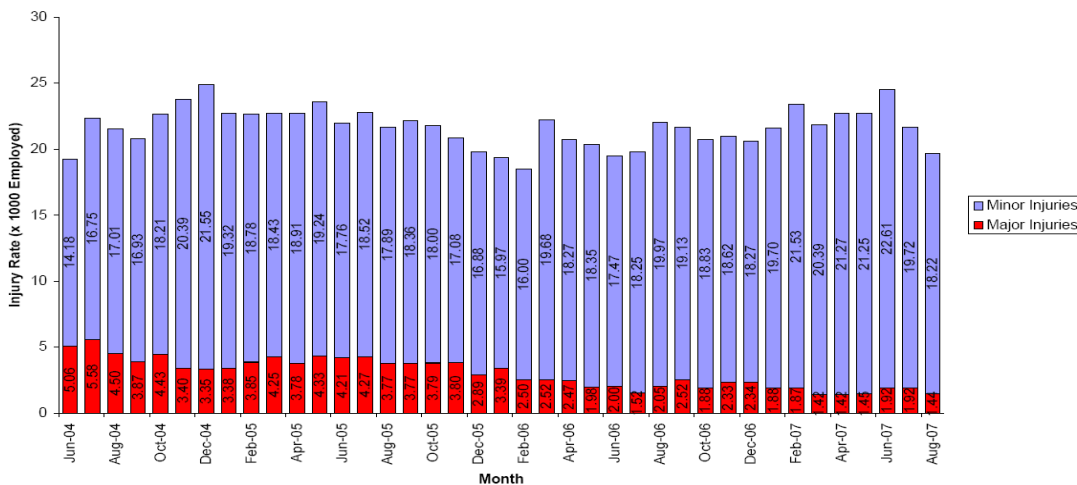
Statistics

Types of Injury

Largest contributor to accidents is again “slipped, tripped or fell on the same level.” The Advisory Committee will look at this topic afresh over the rest of 2007 and into 2008. After a campaign in 2006 where improvements were seen we now appear to have dropped back. After concerns were raised to Members of the failure to include F2508 details with all reported accidents we are now regularly receiving the forms; this should improve the analysis going forward and the Committee have also agreed to assign all accidents during future meetings to ensure consistency. This should help in allocating resource to issues that can make a real difference to the injury stats. We also plan to invite an IWPPA and CPI small independent to future meetings of the Committee to try to get a better cross industry position on issues that need investigation.
