### **Issue**

1. To seek SMT endorsement of the proposed response to the BERR consultation on extending the scope of the Regulators' Compliance Code and the Principles of Good Regulation to specific functions of Local Authorities in Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales, as well as to certain functions of public sector regulators in England.

### **Recommendation**

2. The Senior Management Team is asked to:
  - i. Agree that HSE should respond to the BERR Consultation and support the proposal.
  - ii. Agree the contents of the Board paper and the draft letter to be sent to BERR from the HSE Chair.
