<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- an authorisation application where ECHA has not made a final decision granting or refusing the application</li> </ul>	<p>If you are a UK applicant, resubmit your application to the HSE.</p> <p>If you are a DU awaiting a decision for a EU/EEA authorisation application, you will no longer be able to benefit from that authorisation, and will have to apply for a UK REACH authorisation.
