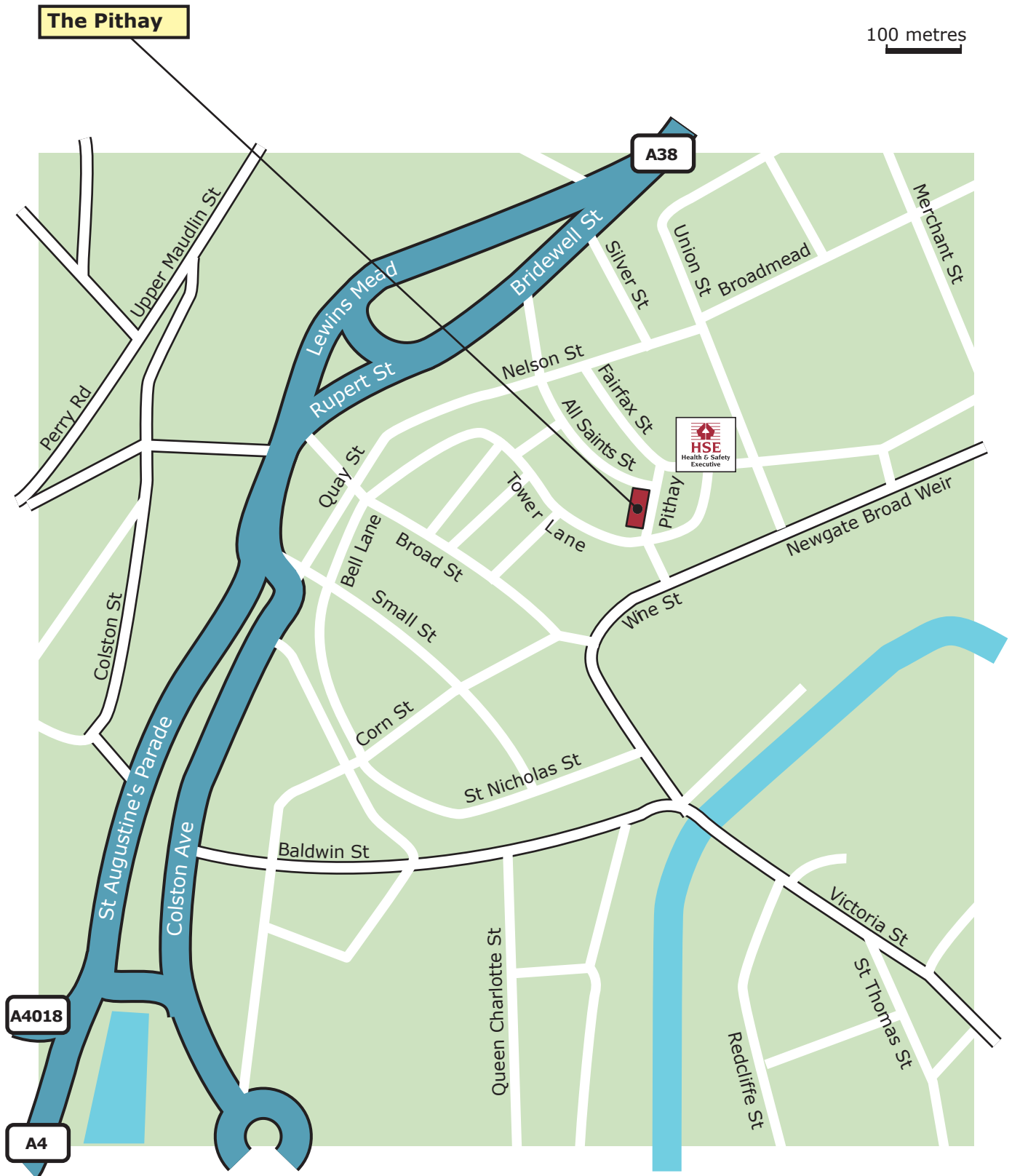

How To Find Us

By Road

From **M4** leave at **Junction 19**, and onto **M32**, Follow **M32** into **Bristol** until it ends and turns into **Newfoundland Street (A4032)**, The road will split into 4 lanes, bear to the right. Go straight through the lights onto **Bond Street**, then get into the left-hand lane. At roundabout, take first exit towards City (onto **The Haymarket** which becomes **Bridewell Street**). Take second available left (through zebra crossing) onto **All Saints Street**. You are in a one-way system. Turn left onto **Nelson Street**, then turn immediately right onto **Fairfax Street** (the **NCP** car park will be on your right). Take next right again to park in **NCP** (50p/ 15mins). Exit the **NCP** on foot through main entrance/exit, and turn right. Continue forward until you reach **St John's Steep** and turn left. Continue and turn left into **Tower Lane**. Steps to the office are on the left and the **West End entrance** will be directly in front of you.

If you choose to walk up the hill '**The Pithay**', please be aware this direction poses an increased risk to pedestrians due to extremely narrow footways and severe restrictions on vehicles passing each other safely.

By Rail

When you come out of the main station entrance continue down incline to the main road and, turn right along **Temple Gate**. Bear right and cross roundabout to go down **Victoria Street**. Continue over **Bristol Bridge**, bear right onto **Wine Street**. Turn left onto **Pithay**, then turn left into **All Saints Street**. The main entrance is now in front of you.

Where to Park

There are no parking facilities for visitors at **The Pithay**. Visitors may use the public car park in **Nelson Street** and there are several other car parks nearby
