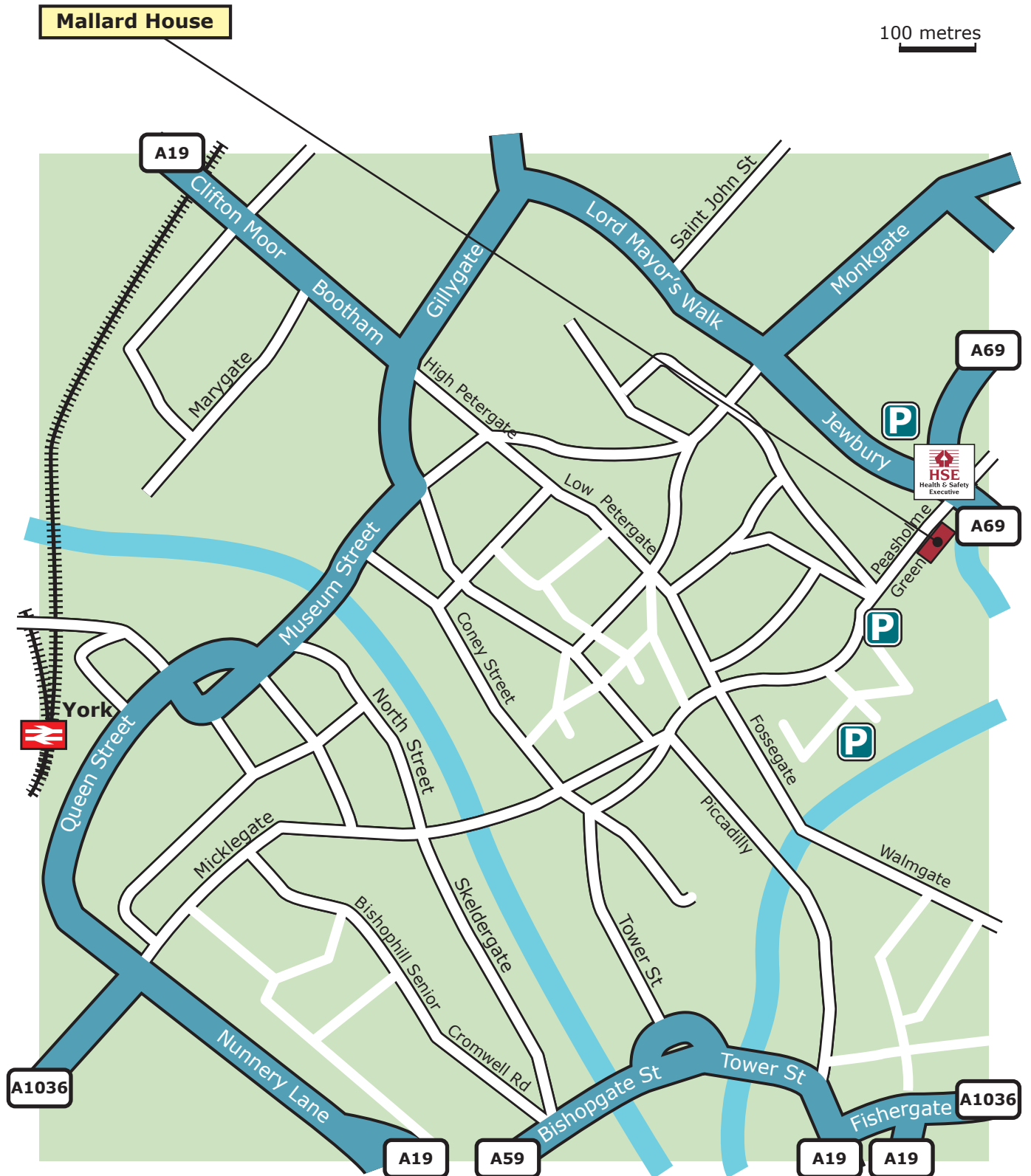

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## How To Find Us

### By Road

If you are traveling **North** on the **M1** or **A1**, you will come to the new intersection with the **A64**, only 15 minutes away from the city via dual carriageway. Traveling **South** on the **A1**, you will also leave the motorway at the **A64** intersection. Traveling from the **West** on the **M62**, join the **M1 northbound** until you reach the intersection with the **A64**. **York** is also served by the **A19**, the **A1079** and the **A166** routes into the city.

New visitors are advised to leave the **A64 ring road** at the **A166/A1079** junction on the Eastern side of the City, and follow **Hull Road** straight towards York city centre.

At the junction opposite the **City Wall (Walmgate Bar)**, turn right at the traffic lights into **Foss Islands Road**. Straight ahead at the traffic lights by **Morrisons** and at the next set of traffic lights, (**T junction; Staples** and **Allied Carpets** on your right), take the middle lane and go straight across into the right lane, as the road bends to the right there is a sign for **Foss Bank Shoppers car park**, this is the closest parking and is Pay and Display (currently 70p per hour). Coming back out of the car park on foot turn left and walk back to the traffic lights turn right at the junction and **Kings Pool** is on your left.

### By Bus

Frequent **Park and Ride** bus services (every **10** minutes) operate into the city centre from sites on the City's outer ring road.

### By Rail

Trains run from **Liverpool** and take roughly two and a half hours **every half hour** with at least 2 direct trains each weekday. York is also the **East Coast mainline** around two hours from **London, Kings Cross**. Trains run every half. Direct rail services also run from York to many of the UK's main regional centres.

**Kings Pool** is approximately a **15-20 minute walk** from **York station** through the city centre. Taxis are available outside the station and the journey to **Kings Pool** takes about 10 minutes and costs about **£4.00-£4.50**.

Leave the railway station, turn left across two zebra crossings passing **The Royal York Hotel**, walk past the pelican crossing on your right. Continue until you reach a pelican crossing at the Crossroad. Cross the road and follow the footpath round under the archway; continue and cross **Lendal Bridge**. Follow the path to **Museum Gardens** on your left and cross the road (signposted '**City Centre**'). Follow the path past the **Judges Lodging Hotel** to **Harkers Bar** on your left. Diagonally cross **St Helens Square** heading for **Betty's cake shop**.

Cross the road to the **Sports Direct** shop on your left you are now in **Daveygate**, follow the road to **Browns Department Store** and pass some public telephones. Keep walking on the left, cross the road passing **D&A Opticians**, **Pret a Manger**, **M&S** and the **Halifax Bank**.

Cross at the pelican crossing (towards **Lloyds TSB**) and turn left. Pass the **Terrace Public House** on your right, with the **Job Centre** on your left. You will approach a mini roundabout. Keep straight ahead towards the **Hungate** building works, until you pass the **Black Swan Public House**. **The Kings Pool** site is on your right, immediately after the entrance to the Public House car park.

### Where to Park?
