COMAH L111 Erratum

PURPOSE

This SLC brings to the attention of HID inspectors, and others with cause to access the document, an error in guidance document L111 'A guide to the Control of Major Accident Hazards Regulations 1999 (as amended)'.

L111 was revised in 2006 to reflect amendments to the COMAH Regulations. The guide is aimed at operators of establishments and others with duties under the Regulations.

An error has been identified at page 88 of L111 under the heading 'highly flammable liquids' at **Schedule 1, Part 3; 3(b)(ii)** where there is a typing error and the words '**substances and preparations**' were erroneously changed to '**gases**'. Para 3(b)(ii) was unaffected by the amendments to the regulations.

The full correct sentence at 3(b)(ii) in L111 (page 88) should read:

'(ii)substances and preparations which have a flash point lower than 21^oC and which are not extremely flammable (risk phrase R11, second indent); and'

HSE books have been told about this and they should be putting erratum slips in any copies of L111 sold.
