

Is simply a two-way process where you and your employees:


- talk to one another

Barriers

- Cost
- PPE and use of equipment
- First Aid training workers feeling that they were not receiving enough training
- Shift working patterns
- Communication, at all levels and particularly during shift handovers
- Perceived inconsistency of management behaviour up and down the organisation
- Time pressures, for example releasing workers from the shop floor for meetings and discussions

Action planning

Start from where you are- identify next step
Don't second guess response- avoid cynicism
Give yourself best chance of success- test against
SMART

- **✓ SPECIFIC** what exactly is the action?
- **✓ MEASURABLE** how will we know it's successful?
- **✓ ACHIEVABLE** is it possible to do?
- **▼RELEVANT** is it the right person and part of their role?
- **✓TIME FRAME** by when, and when review?
