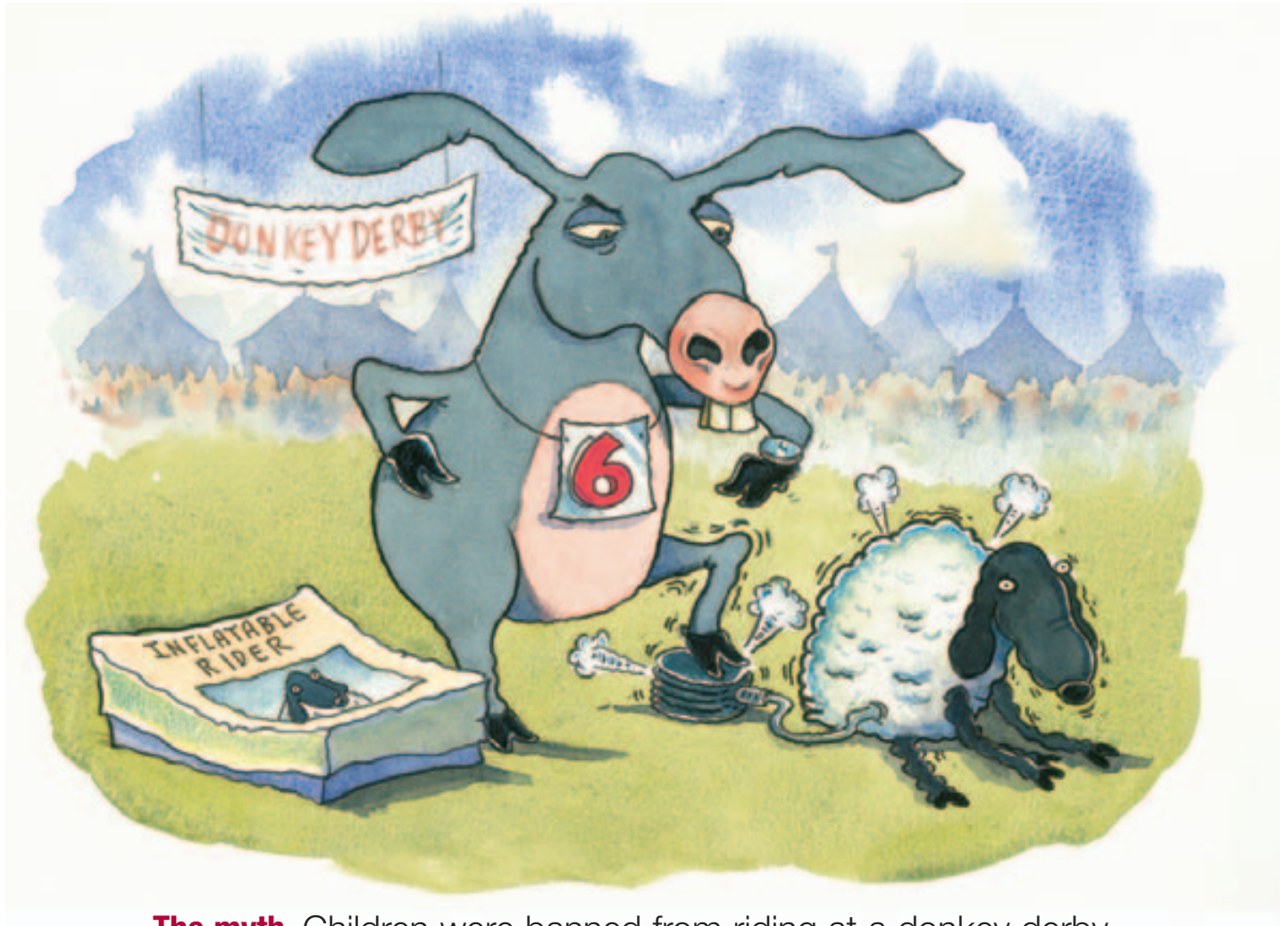


# Great health and safety myths
