OCNS Requirements for New Build

Three key steps:

1. **Conceptual Security Plan** – output of GDA process
2. **Construction Security Plan** – authorised prior to construction start and owned by the Site Licensee
3. **Site Security Plan** – operating prior to fuel being brought to site

Conceptual Security Plan:



- Output from the GDA process related to generic plant.
- Agreed physical and IT security requirements to meet OCNS's technical requirements.
- Developed by OCNS and the RPs with support from ND safety specialists as necessary.

Construction Security Plan:

Will be owned by the Licensee

Will include all aspects of the **Conceptual Plan**

Will detail **'whole site'** security arrangements and development to the site security plan

Will demonstrate continued **integrity of adjacent facilities security plans** during the construction and subsequent operation of the plant.

Site Security Plan:

1. **Owned by the Licensee.**
2. **Fully operational**, including accommodation of ongoing construction and commissioning activities, **prior to nuclear fuel being brought to site.**
3. Clearly defined Director level responsibility and reporting lines defined.
