 - (c) sensing components (used as neutron detector)
 - (d) Pu with Pu-238 content greater than 80%
11. Intended use: *(e.g. shielding, radiography, research)*
12. Particular safeguards obligation: *if the material has a third country obligation otherwise enter N for non obligated materials)*
13. Date of transfer From **(completed only when requesting derogation for receipt of **purchased** nuclear material)**

Explanatory Notes

This form should be used either when requesting the first initial derogation from the rules governing the form and frequency of reports, or when nuclear material is purchased from outside the European Community.

Point 13 should only be used for **purchases** from outside the European Community, and should state the name and address of the shipper.

A separate request should be submitted for each type of derogation (Article 19(2)).

NB:

Under Article 79 of the Treaty, those subject to safeguards requirements shall notify the authorities of the Member State concerned of any communications they make to the European Commission pursuant to Article 78 and the first paragraph of Article 79 of the Treaty.
