Article 2	Adoption of harmonised testing method for cement.	European Commission to implement.
Article 3	Dates for publication and application of provisions of Directive 2003/53/EC. Reference to Directive 2003/53/EC.	Regulation 1 of COSHH 2004. Paragraph 2 of Explanatory Note to COSHH 2004.
